Formula Maintenance

Now that we are in the thick of boating season, we would like to talk about maintenance items that will keep your Formula boat running like a dream for years to come. No matter if you are a freshwater or saltwater boater, these are items that need to be frequently checked during the boating season.

Sea Strainer:

1. Locate and Access the Strainer:

Sea strainers are typically located on the inlet side of raw water pumps. They often have a removable housing or lid.

2. Remove the Strainer Basket:

Unscrew the top lid or housing to access the strainer basket. Pull out the strainer basket.

3. Clean the Strainer Basket:

Rinse the basket with fresh water to remove loose debris.

Use a brush or gentle scrubbing if necessary to remove more stubborn debris.

Inspect the O-ring (or gasket) for wear and damage.

4. Inspect and Clean the Strainer Housing:

Check the housing for any sediment or debris buildup. You can flush the housing with fresh water to remove any loose debris. If there's significant corrosion or sediment, consider using a mild solution like vinegar or muriatic acid.

5. Reassemble the Strainer

Check to make sure water is flowing and everything is watertight.
